REGISTRARS & MEDICAL STUDENTS

We will often have a trainee GP in post. These are qualified doctors who are completing their general practice training in Queen Camel. They are normally in post for 1 year and will see patients in the same way as the partners. Occasionally Medical Students will be present with the doctor and patients will be informed by a note on the book-in screen. They are normally with us for 2 weeks and will only see patients under supervision.

You can choose to stop your confidential patient information being used for research and planning. You can also make a choice for someone else like your children under the age of 13. Your choice will only apply to the health and care system in England. This does not apply to health or care services accessed in Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland.

The dispensary is open from **8.45 am to 1.00 pm** and then from **3.00 pm** to **6.00 pm**.

Please note that as of the 1st April 2023 we are longer accepting answer phone messages as a method of requesting medication. This is for safety reasons.

To speak to a dispenser please phone between **9.30 and 11am**. We require 1 weeks' notice to make up repeat prescriptions. Only certain patients are eligible to receive dispensing services and unfortunately, we cannot offer dispensary services to a patient who lives within one mile of a local pharmacy (as the crow flies). This is an NHS regulation.


FACILITIES
